

# La Garfagnana - Nidi Holiday Home in Ridracoli

Set in a quiet natural landscape in Ridracoli, I Nidi Holiday Home is a traditional sandstone house in the Romagna Apennines, divided into four fully independent mini-apartments. Located on two floors, the four apartments-LUPO, CERVO, SCOIATTOLO, AND ISTRICE-are ideal for guests seeking a relaxing stay, whether for a family holiday, a romantic break, or a restful stop during a multi-day trekking experience.

## Each apartment includes:


- one bedroom
- one bathroom with a shower and a hairdryer
- a living area with a sofa bed and a kitchenette, refrigerator, and microwave oven

The kitchenette is provided with basic equipment for the number of guests, including pots and pans, water pitchers, glasses, a Moka coffee pot, and cutlery. Kitchen and table linen are not provided. Two of the apartments can accommodate up to 4 guests, while the other two can host up to 5 guests (double bed, single bed, and double sofa bed). All apartments are fitted with mosquito screens and USB charging sockets. There are no shared indoor areas. An outdoor barbecue area is available; grill racks can be provided free of charge upon request. The property is accessible by car and offers free parking.



- Utilities (water, electricity, gas) and heating when required
  - Cleaning service
